## Wavy Wash Cloth Pattern

Materials needed: 5.0 mm crochet hook Darning needle Worsted weight cotton yarn - 50 g Scissors

ch - chain sc - single crochet hdc - half double crochet dc - double crochet sts - stitches

## Ch 31.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts, \*hdc in each of the next 3 sts, dc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc in each of the next 3 sts, sc in each of the next 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* until last 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: \*hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* until last 6 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, ch 1, turn

Row 3: dc in next 3 sts, \*hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts. Repeat from \* to \* until last 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: \*hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* until last 6 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, turn.

Repeat rows 1-4 twice more, for a total of 12 rows, or until desired length.

Work 1 round of sc around the outside, working 3sc in each corner. Fasten off and weave in ends.

If you are feeling adventurous, or just want to show off the wave pattern more, change colours on rows 1 and 3.
